POOL RULES

All clubs and institutions have rules and we are no exception. These few rules are for the well being of the club, please adhere to them. The pool may be used by current members between 8.00 & 9.30 pm. only, and members are only allowed into the water when a suitably qualified pool marshal is in attendance.

1. Always follow the instructions of the pool marshal.
2. Divers may enter the water from 8.30pm onwards, clearing the pool by 9.30pm.
3. No diving into the water and over arm swimming strokes only allowed at the the pool marshals discretion.
4. When entering the water always check below first for suitable depth and that the water below is clear, there may be a diver submerged.
5. Trainees must not enter the water until advised to do so by their instructor.
6. Trainees who require equipment will not enter the water until they have met the equipment officer at the poolside and collected the necessary equipment from him. After training has ceased, the trainee will ensure that the equipment is **washed** and promptly returned to the equipment officer that evening.
7. If any equipment is found to be faulty, please inform the equipment officer.
8. Always stow equipment sensibly around the pool, do not block walkways etc.
9. If using weights, do not ditch them causing them to drop to the tiles on the bottom of the pool, unless in an emergency.
10. Only clean equipment is allowed in the pool.
11. Strictly no 'horseplay' allowed in and around the pool.
12. No uncoated lead weights allowed in the pool.
13. No unauthorized entry into the pool store room.
14. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.
15. No personal possessions to be left in the changing rooms.
(as no responsibility is accepted for loss or theft of property from poolside or changing rooms).

These simple rules have been drawn up for your safety and to ensure continued use of the pool for you, the members. Please adhere to them.
